



# Congregation Temple Israel

To Whom It May Concern:

Congregation Temple Israel was originally built in 1960. Over the past 25 years the Temple has deferred maintenance of major components of the facility. In 2007 the Temple a team of individuals from its members to launch a capital campaign.

This campaign is ongoing and over the course of the past 24 months developed a master plan and program to bring the facility up to today's standards. One of the first projects undertaken was to address roofing issues, which have caused problems both daily and annually to the operations of the Temple.
